



DECORATIONS POLICY

The sanctuary is, by design, a place of beauty and dignity. Therefore, decorations for the sanctuary should be kept within the bounds of simplicity and good taste.

Baskets, candelabrum, aisle cloths, or a kneeling bench should be furnished by the florist or other rental facility and removed at the conclusion of the ceremony. Equipment may be delivered Friday afternoon or Saturday morning. Please make arrangements with the wedding coordinator. If equipment cannot be picked up after the ceremony, please make sure the church has the appropriate place to store these items. Seven Rivers is not responsible for any missing or broken rental items.

Decorations cannot be nailed, screwed, tacked, taped, or wired to the walls, woodwork, or pews of the church. Rice, confetti, birdseed or similar materials may not be used inside the church buildings. Decorations should be secured to the pews with ribbon or similar material.

The florist must provide adequate mats or cloths to be placed under the candle fixtures to protect the floor and woodwork. Please use only drip-less candles.

Because of fire regulations, please make sure exits are left free of decorations.

The church's seasonal decorations (Christmas trees, banners, etc.) should not be moved or removed. Please consult the wedding coordinator for details.

Choir chairs should not be moved or removed from the choir loft. All musical instruments and sound equipment will be moved to the sides of the stage by church staff.

The florist or wedding party should notify the church of the intended decorating plans in advance. If you have any questions, please contact our wedding coordinator.
