SET FREE ON THE SABBATH

Luke 13:10-21

I. FREEDOM COMES WHEN WE KNOW WE ARE TIED UP

(Luke 13:10, 14) On a Sabbath Jesus was teaching in one of the synagogues, ...Indignant because Jesus had healed on the Sabbath, the synagogue ruler said to the people, "There are six days for work. So come and be healed on those days, not on the Sabbath."

II. FREEDOM COMES AT THE END OF YOURSELF

(Luke 13:15, 17) The Lord answered him, "You hypocrites! Doesn't each of you on the Sabbath untie his ox or donkey from the stall and lead it out to give it water?" ...When he said this, all his opponents were humiliated, but the people were delighted with all the wonderful things he was doing.

III. FREEDOM COMES IN BEING FAVORED BY GOD

(Luke 13:16, 19, 14b) "Then should not this woman, a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan has kept bound for eighteen long years, be set free on the Sabbath day from what bound her?" ..."It is like a mustard seed, which a man took and planted in his garden. It grew and became a tree, and the birds of the air perched in its branches." ..."There are six days for work. So come and be healed on those days, not on the Sabbath."
