## THE WEIGHT OF GLORY

Luke 9:28-36

### I. OUR GLORY LONGING

(Luke 9:33) As the men were leaving Jesus, Peter said to Him, "Master, it is good for us to be here. Let us put up three shelters—one for You, one for Moses and one for Elijah." (Romans 3:23) All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

### II. THE GLORY OF CHRIST

#### A. The Greatness of Christ

(Luke 9:34-35) While he was speaking, a cloud appeared and enveloped them, and they were afraid as they entered the cloud. A voice came from the cloud, saying, "This is my Son, whom I have chosen; listen to Him."

#### B. The Glory of His Weakness

(Luke 9:31) ...appeared in glorious splendor, talking with Jesus. They spoke about His departure, which He was about to bring to fulfillment at Jerusalem.

#### C. Worship His Glory

(Luke 9:36) When the voice had spoken, they found that Jesus was alone.

### III. THE GIFT OF GLORY

#### A. Glorious Intimacy

(John 17:22, 24) I have given them the glory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one. Father, I want those You have given me to be with me where I am, and to see my glory, the glory you have given me because You loved me before the creation of the world.

#### B. Glorious Future

(I John 3:2) Beloved, now we are children of God and what we will be has not yet been made known. But we know that when He appears we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is. All who have this hope purify themselves as He is pure. (I Corinthians 15:51) Listen, I tell you a mystery: We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed.
