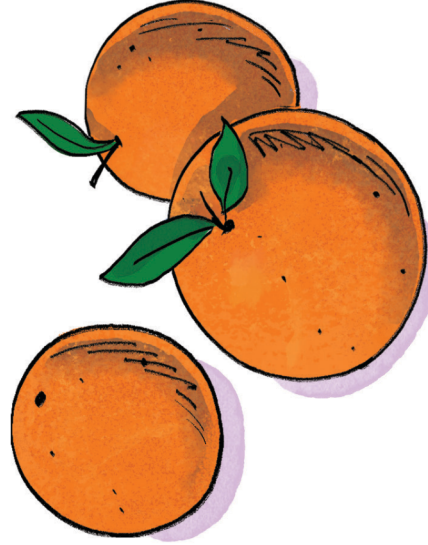
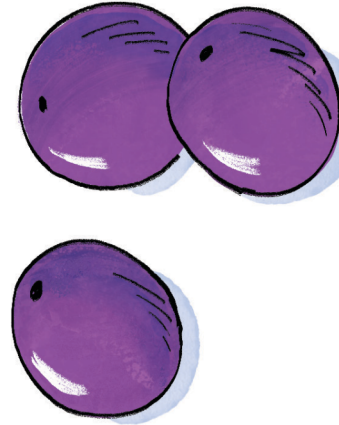
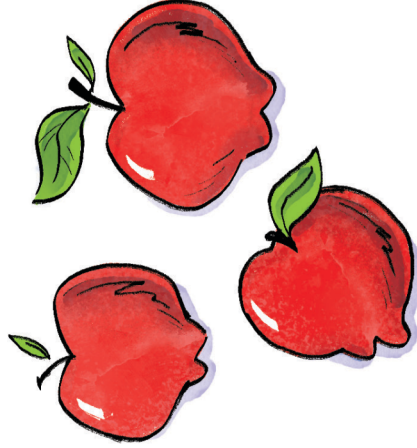
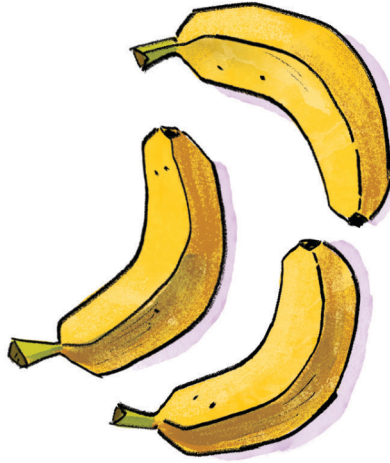


Dividing Lines
