OLD COVENANT, NEW COVENANT

Color the statements red if they describe the old covenant, or color them yellow if they describe the new covenant.



New Covenant:

the agreement God made with people that He will give us new hearts and forgive our sin



Old Covenant:

the agreement God made with His people based on their obedience to the Law

Jesus gave His perfect life as a sacrifice for the forgiveness of sin.	God accepts us into His family and gives us the Holy Spirit. Nothing can separate us from Him.	Because of Jesus, God remembers our sin no more. We die to sins and live for righteousness.	The blood of Jesus purifies us from all sin.
Make offerings and sacrifices such as grain and animals as payment for sin.	Offer two goats—one killed and one sent into the wilderness—to remove the sins of the people.	Sprinkle blood in the temple to purify, or wash away, the sins of the people.	Observe the Day of Atonement as God's loving way to make His people holy.
