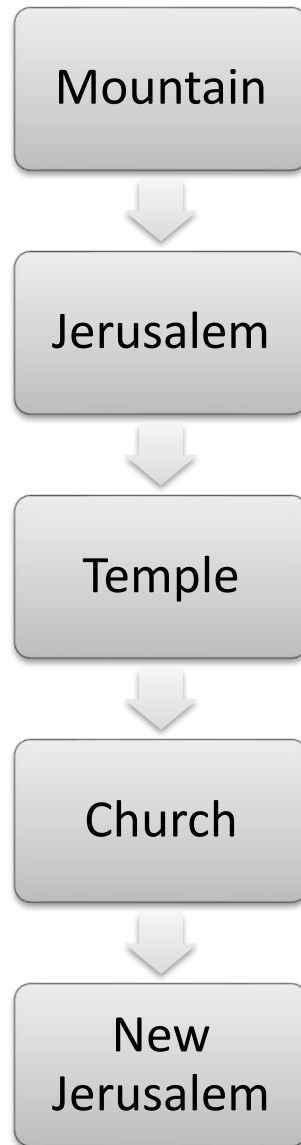

Psalm 2:6 - "As for me, I have set my King on Zion, my holy hill."

Psalm 9:11,14 - Sing praises to the LORD, who sits enthroned in Zion! Tell among the peoples his deeds!...that I may recount all your praises, that in the gates of the daughter of Zion I may rejoice in your salvation.

Psalm 14:7 - Oh, that salvation for Israel would come out of Zion! When the LORD restores the fortunes of his people, let Jacob rejoice, let Israel be glad.

Psalm 20:2 - May he send you help from the sanctuary and give you support from Zion!

Psalm 48:2,11,12 - beautiful in elevation, is the joy of all the earth, Mount Zion, in the far north, the city of the great King...Let Mount Zion be glad! Let the daughters of Judah rejoice because of your judgments!...Walk about Zion, go around her, number her towers,

Psalm 50:2 - Out of Zion, the perfection of beauty, God shines forth.

Psalm 51:18 - Do good to Zion in your good pleasure; build up the walls of Jerusalem;

Psalm 53:6 - Oh, that salvation for Israel would come out of Zion! When God restores the fortunes of his people, let Jacob rejoice, let Israel be glad.

Psalm 65:1 - To the choirmaster. A Psalm of David. A Song. Praise is due to you, O God, in Zion, and to you shall vows be performed.

Psalm 69:35 - For God will save Zion and build up the cities of Judah, and people shall dwell there and possess it;

Psalm 74:2 - Remember your congregation, which you have purchased of old, which you have redeemed to be the tribe of your heritage! Remember Mount Zion, where you have dwelt.

Psalm 76:2 - His abode has been established in Salem, his dwelling place in Zion.

Psalm 78:68 - but he chose the tribe of Judah, Mount Zion, which he loves.

Psalm 84:5,7 - Blessed are those whose strength is in you, in whose heart are the highways to Zion...They go from strength to strength; each one appears before God in Zion.

Psalm 87:2,5 - the LORD loves the gates of Zion more than all the dwelling places of Jacob...And of Zion it shall be said, "This one and that one were born in her"; for the Most High himself will establish her.

Psalm 97:8 - Zion hears and is glad, and the daughters of Judah rejoice, because of your judgments, O LORD.

Psalm 99:2 - The LORD is great in Zion; he is exalted over all the peoples.

Psalm 102:13,16,21 - You will arise and have pity on Zion; it is the time to favor her; the appointed time has come...For the LORD builds up Zion; he appears in his glory...that they may declare in Zion the name of the LORD, and in Jerusalem his praise,

Psalm 110:2 - The LORD sends forth from Zion your mighty scepter. Rule in the midst of your enemies!

Psalm 125:1 - A Song of Ascents. Those who trust in the LORD are like Mount Zion, which cannot be moved, but abides forever.

Psalm 126:1 - A Song of Ascents. When the LORD restored the fortunes of Zion, we were like those who dream.

Psalm 128:5 - The LORD bless you from Zion! May you see the prosperity of Jerusalem all the days of your life!

Psalm 129:5 - May all who hate Zion be put to shame and turned backward!

Psalm 132:13 - For the LORD has chosen Zion; he has desired it for his dwelling place:

Psalm 133:3 - It is like the dew of Hermon, which falls on the mountains of Zion! For there the LORD has commanded the blessing, life forevermore.

Psalm 134:3 - May the LORD bless you from Zion, he who made heaven and earth!

Psalm 135:21 - Blessed be the LORD from Zion, he who dwells in Jerusalem! Praise the LORD!

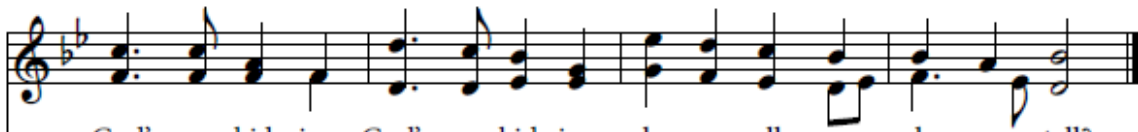
