

WELLNESS POLICY

We ask that you not bring a child to church that appears to be ill. This is for the protection of your child as well as the other children. If your child has, or has had in the last 24 hours, any of the following symptoms, please do not bring or send them to the children's area:

- Fever
- Sore throat
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Croup

- Any unexplained rash
- Pink eye or other eye infection
- Common cold, from onset through one week
- Any skin infection: boils, ringworm, impetigo
- Any symptom of childhood disease such as scarlet fever, German measles, mumps, chicken pox, whooping cough
- If your child develops a fever or other symptoms of illness while he/she is in the children's area, he/she will be isolated and you will be notified.
- If your child develops an infectious disease (measles, mumps, chicken pox, etc.) after being in the children's area, please notify us immediately (352.746.6200; charper@sevenrivers.org)
- All medications must be administered by a parent/guardian.
- Parents should indicate any allergies your child has at the time of arrival.
- For sanitation purposes, we request that you use disposable diapers when you bring your child to the children's area. This helps eliminate the spread of germs. Cloth diapers and soiled clothing are not rinsed out. They will be returned to you in a plastic bag.
