# **Warm-Up Question:**

Describe situations you've experienced where you are thankful that God is just and gives judgment, whether small or large situations.

READ: Genesis 6:5-14, 17-19, 7:17-19; 8:1-2

# I. JUDGMENT: VIOLENCE

- From the verses you read describing the story of the flood, describe the justice of God against human wickedness.
- ▶ How does knowing God is a righteous judge enable you to forgive someone who has wronged you? (Discuss Rom. 12:17-21 to go deeper)
