# I. MISSION LOST

- ▶ From Gen. 1:22, 28; 8:17, 9:1, 7 and WCF Q.1 (to the right), what is the purpose of man and what does it mean practically?
- From Gen. 11:4, how did sin affect the purpose of man as seen through this story? Why was it so sinful to God & their original mission?
- ➢ How do you see similar sinful purposes, like trying to make a name for yourself, in the world and also in yourself?
