Genesis 17 — The Covenant

Warm-Up Question:

Discuss a time in your life where you felt powerless, hopeless or stuck.

READ: Genesis 17

I. COVENANT: PROMISES

- What are some of the promises God makes from Genesis 17:1-8?

- ▶ Why is circumcision a sign of the covenant (Ray gave 5 reasons)? How does the story in Genesis 15 important to understanding this sign?

- ➢ How do we see Jesus being "cut off" on the cross and what is the significance of it for us?
- ▶ How does God's faithfulness to the covenant and Jesus sacrifice in the covenant motivate you to strive to be faithful in our covenant with God?
