# Warm-Up Question:

# READ: Genesis 27:1-45

# I. THE BLESSING: SCANDAL

- ▶ From Genesis 27, track through the reasons that both Esau and Jacob prove themselves as unworthy of being blessed?
- Name some other people in the Bible that God choses to bless but are so undeserving of it. Why does God give his blessing to such undeserving people?

# II. THE BLESSING: SOVEREIGNTY OF GOD

- In the midst of everyone doing everything wrong in this passage, how do you see God's sovereign control over Jacob's life?
- In the life and death of Jesus, how do you see the mystery of how God uses the sin and evil of men to accomplish His purposes?
