

COLOSSIANS: THE MYSTERY

Colossians

Warm-Up Question:

Life Groups aim to <u>Connect Relationally</u>, <u>Grow Spiritually</u>, & <u>Serve Intentionally</u>. What's one area your LG could grow in and one practical way to grow in it?

READ: COLOSSIANS 1:24-2:5

I. THE MYSTERY: WHAT IS IT?

- What is this "mystery" from 1:26-27 & 2:2-3?
- How was this a "mystery" to the people of God in Old Testament ages? (Ex. The temple & meeting with God - 1 Cor. 3:16; 6:19). How would they have described their "hope of glory" (having a land, a king, a kingdom, etc)
- ▶ What is the significance of Christ being "in you" and this "hope of glory"? (Go deeper with 1 Cor. 1:30, John 17:21-26)

II. THE MYSTERY: WHO GETS IT?

- ▶ From vs. 27, 3:11, and Eph. 3:4-6, who is this mystery for? Think about each of these groups. Why was this so scandalous to the Jews?
- ▶ Was there ever a time where you considered yourself less qualified than others to have this hope? Do you struggle with it now?
- Is there any type of person where your heart subtly think they don't deserve this as much as you (think background, race, political views, etc)?

III. THE MYSTERY: WHAT DIFFERENCE DOES IT MAKE?

- What difference does Christ in us make in the midst of our suffering (see Vs. 24; Rom. 5:1-5; 2 Cor. 4:16-17)?
- What difference does Christ in us make in how we relate to others (see 1:28-2:2; 3:8-14)?
- What difference does Christ in us make in our assurance before God (see 2:2-4; 1 John 5:11-12; if time Rom. 8:31-39)?

What is one main take-away you want to apply in your life this week?

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
