## **GOD: OMNISCIENT**

#### Warm-Up Question:

What are some random things you know that you think no one else might know?

NOTE: There are lots of passages this week. I recommend dividing up the verses and having them read out loud.

- READ Ps. 147:4-5, Is. 46:9-10, Dan. 2:22, & Ps. 50:10-11. Describe 4-5 things from these verses that describe the extent of God's knowledge.
- READ Is. 40:13-14, 55:8-9, Rom. 11:33. What are some appropriate reactions to knowing that God knows all things? How does it make you feel?
- READ Ps. 139:1-3, 13-16; Ps. 44:21. Describe some ways God knows you and how that makes you feel to be known like this.

#### II. Omniscient: KNOWLEDGE OF OURSELF

- Think of some things you've thought, said and done that you would hope no one would find out about. Then **READ** Ps. 10:11; 90:8; Jer. 17:10; Heb. 4:13 and share what these verses say about those things.
- READ 1 John 3:20-21. What is God verdict about our heart, even if/when we condemn ourself? What should this lead us to feel before God? (Read the quote in the sidebar to help)
- READ Heb. 10:12, 14, 18-22 and share why God feels this toward us even though he knows all things about us.
- READ Ps. 56:8; Matt. 6:8; Matt. 10:29-31. In what way does God understand your anxiety and suffering? What should you feel as a result?

What is one main take-away you want to apply in your life this week?

To us who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope that is set before us in the gospel, how unutterably sweet is the knowledge that our Heavenly Father knows us completely.
