# The Gospel of Luke: Meeting Our Savior

## **Warm-Up Question:**

Post-modernism taught there is no truth and you can't trust any authority. Our culture then added a self-centeredness, where all truth and authority comes from you. How might that affect a view God's authority & desire to live under it?

**READ: Luke 4:31-44** 

### I. WHO IS YOUR ULTIMATE AUTHORITY

- What is your experience with living under authority? Did you grow up leaning into trusting or distrusting those who had authority over your life?
- How do you think your story and past experiences might affect your desire and ability to trust and live under God's authority?

#### II. WHY SHOULD IT BE JESUS

- From the stories in this passage, how do you see Jesus demonstrating his authority? (Don't skip over 31-32, 43-44) Authority over what things?
- Discuss Jesus the extent of Jesus' authority from Eph. 1:20-23, Phil. 2:9-11, & Col. 1:16-18.
- ▶ Read v. 36-37. What was their reaction to Jesus authority and power. How do you think that affected their view of Jesus, and how should it affect ours?
- Think about the phrase "every one of them" in v. 40. Then read Matt. 11:28-30. Discuss how Jesus wants to use his authority in your life.

#### III. WHAT DIFFERENCE SHOULD IT MAKE

- We have the world, our flesh and the devil constantly tempting us to live under their authority. Describe how Jesus has authority over each and why it matters.
- ▶ How did they demonstrate trust in Jesus' authority in v. 38? What are practical ways we can demonstrate trust in Jesus' authority in our daily life?
