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Warm-Up Question:

What is your experience with Christian education? What's your knowledge of how Seven Rivers Christian School as a primary ministry of our church?

READ: Proverbs 3:1-35

I. THE NEED FOR CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

- Read Prov. 1:7 and discuss how and why true knowledge begins with the fear of the LORD?
- Read 3:19 and the quote in the sidebar. Why should all true knowledge and learning be seen through the lens of a Biblical worldview?

II. THE BLESSINGS OF CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

- Prov. 3 shows the great blessings that come by attaining wisdom. Discuss the difference between the way the world and the wisdom of God offers each of the following, as well as the true blessing from the wisdom of God:
 - ▶ True LIFE (v. 8, 17-18)
 - ▶ True WEALTH (v. 9-10, 13-16)
 - True SECURITY (v. 23-26)
 - True PURPOSE

III. THE HEART OF CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

- Read Col. 2:3 and 1 Cor. 1:24. Read Prov. 3:13-19 and replace Christ with "wisdom" and it's pronouns. Discuss how true wisdom come ultimately through a person and not through knowledge alone?
- What is one way this passage and sermon move you to want to grow in wisdom and apply it in your own life?
