I AM THE BREAD OF LIFE

Warm-Up Question:

What's your favorite type of bread and why do you enjoy it so much?

READ: John 6:22-58

I. WHY DO WE COME TO JESUS?

- Why was the crowd seeking Jesus; what did they really want (v. 24-26)?
- What are some wrong motives some might have in going to church or pursuing a relationship with God?
- Read and answer the question in the sidebar honestly. Do you ever feel you have a deeper love for some of God's gifts/blessings over God himself?

II. HOW DO WE COME TO JESUS?

- What is Jesus teaching in v. 44 as to how anyone can have a relationship with God? What is our responsibility?
- How should the truths in v. 37, 39, 44-47 both humble you and also give you security of your salvation? How might it encourage you on your worst days?

III. WHAT DOES JESUS PROMISE WHEN WE DO COME?

- What do you think Jesus means in v. 35, 47-48? What does God want you to experience in your relationship with him?
- Jesus says he will give us "life" 14 times in this passage. Describe what you think this fullness of "life" is in this life and the next?
- How does this motivate you to feast on Christ as your true Bread of Life more than other things in this world?
- What is one thing you might do differently in order to feast on Christ this week?
